# Summary

- Community Ambassador Programme (CAP) is a scheme that has been developed to recruit volunteers from BME & Female communities who will assist the MPS with recruitment of new police officers from under represented communities.

# CAP Role

- Dispel Myths about careers within MPS
- Identify opportunities for recruitment from BME communities
- Identify barriers to employment
- Identify talented individuals with potential to become Police Officers
- Provide advice and information on MPS current and future recruitment campaigns
- Support corporate recruitment campaigns as appropriate

# Eligibility

- Minimum age 18.
- A passion for diversity and building a community
- Proven commitment to making a difference within local communities.
- Strong interpersonal skills to engage with and collaborate with a wide range of people and organisations.
- A commitment to the values of the MPS and associated behaviours
- Commitment to 2 days a month for the role and attend a half day induction session at the start of the role and further development/networking events as set by the co-ordinator.
- Prepared to engage with recruitment initiatives and campaigns pan-London.
