Tottenham Green

- £1.5m public realm and landscaping improvements completed, including children's playground at Tottenham Green East, in February 2015
- £30k Historic England and War Memorial Trust funding secured for improvements to the war memorial commencing 2015

Tottenham Green Leisure Centre

- Since February 2015 the public have been able to enjoy the £8million redevelopment of Fusion's Tottenham Green Pools and Fitness
- The renovated leisure centre has excellent facilities including 3 pools, studios and squash courts, spa, a multi-story play area and a healthy cafe

Tottenham Green Market

- Summer 2014 saw the introduction of Tottenham Green Market, launched to celebrate the re-opening of Tottenham Green after improvement works
- Stalls were filled with locally-made produce such as jams, pastries and cheeses, as well as offering fresh meats and seasonal vegetables sourced from beyond the borough and street food
- Due to its popularity, the market is returning in Summer 2015, starting Saturday 18 July

Tottenham Town Hall and Isobel Place

- The renovation of the Grade II listed Tottenham Town Hall and Newlon Housing Trusts' development Isobel Place, was named as the Best Heritage Led Project at the London Planning Awards, February 2015
